

Denver Train to Airport Commute

It's a bit of a schlep and it takes about an hour and a half door to door, but at \$10 it saves a lot of money and is better for the environment. Here's how to do it:

[You'll need an Airport Day Pass \(\\$10\)](#). The way I did this was to get the Denver RTDMyRide mobile app on your phone. You can also buy tickets before you board the train, but I don't know anything about the ticket machines. Remember to activate your mobile ticket before you board the train.

From the Sheraton Denver West hotel:

- * Walk south past 2 buildings and turn left into the parking lot past the bank. This connects to the path to **Federal Center Station**.
- * **Take the W line to Union Station**. Get off at Union Station, the last stop.
- * **At Union Station, follow the signs to the A line on Track 1**. Go down an escalator and walk all the way through the underground bus concourse. When you take the escalator up at the far end of the concourse, Track 1 is *behind* you (this part is not well signed, unfortunately).
- * **Get on the A train to the airport**, which should be on Track 1. The airport is the last station.

From the airport:

- * Exit at the south door under the American flag.
- * Take the escalator down to the train tracks.
- * Board the A train for Union Station.
- * At Union Station, you'll need to take an escalator down to the concourse that goes under the train tracks. Unfortunately, this area is not well signed.
- * Walk all the way through the concourse and up the escalator at the far end.
- * The W train should be in front of you. Board the W train for Jefferson County - Golden.
- * Get off the W train at Federal Center Station. You'll see the Sheraton hotel. Walk up the ramp or stairs and walk through the parking lot to Union Blvd. Turn right and the hotel is at 360 Union Blvd.
